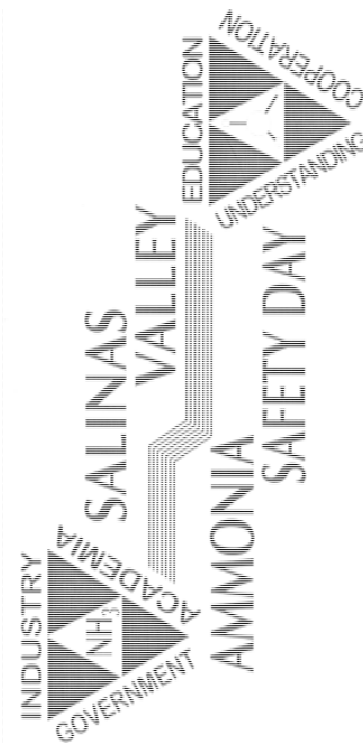

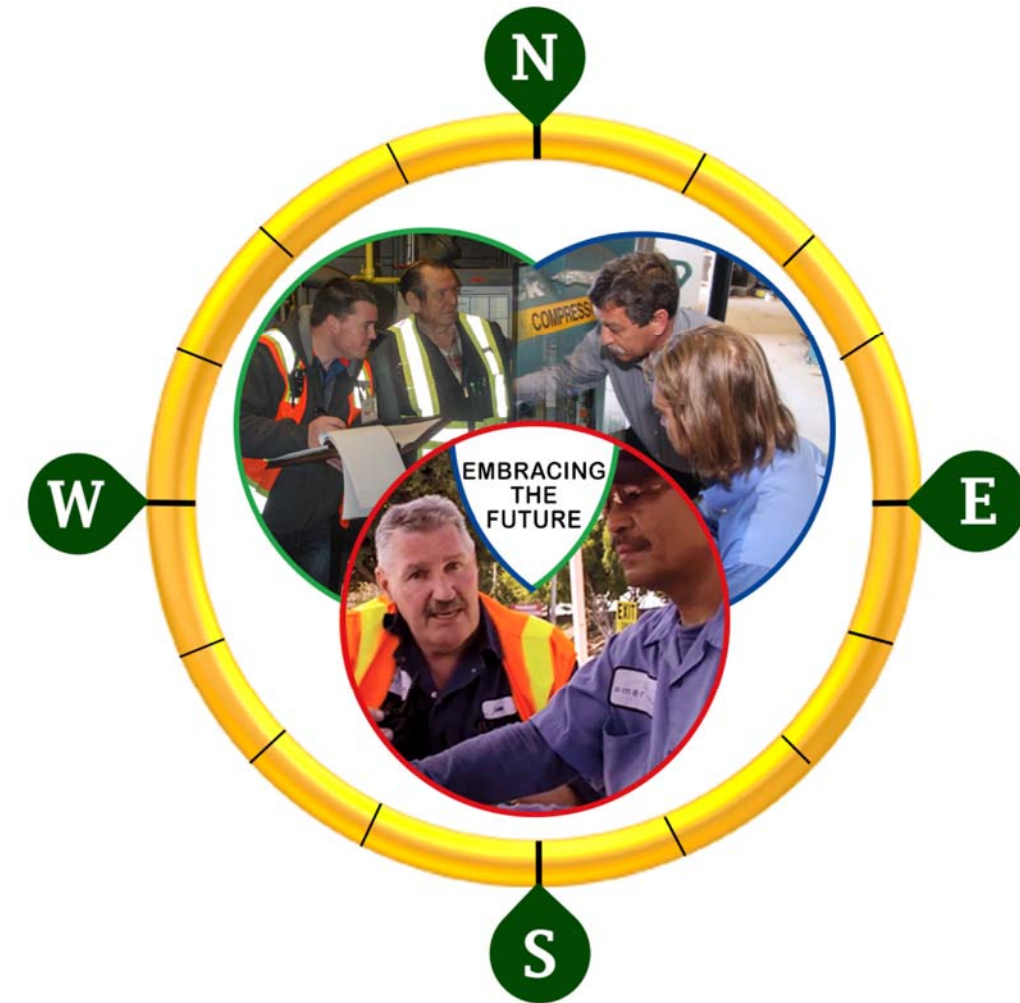

Conflict between 2016 CFC and 2016 CMC regarding ADT Option - Kim Snowden P.E., Snowden Engineering

Fortunately, the 2016 California Fire Code still allows ammonia diffusion tanks (or flaring devices) for pressure relief vents (PRV). However, the 2016 California Mechanical Code has eliminated ammonia diffusion tanks, but still allows flaring devices. Where atmospheric venting is not allowed, ammonia diffusion tanks are strongly preferred, as compared to flaring devices.

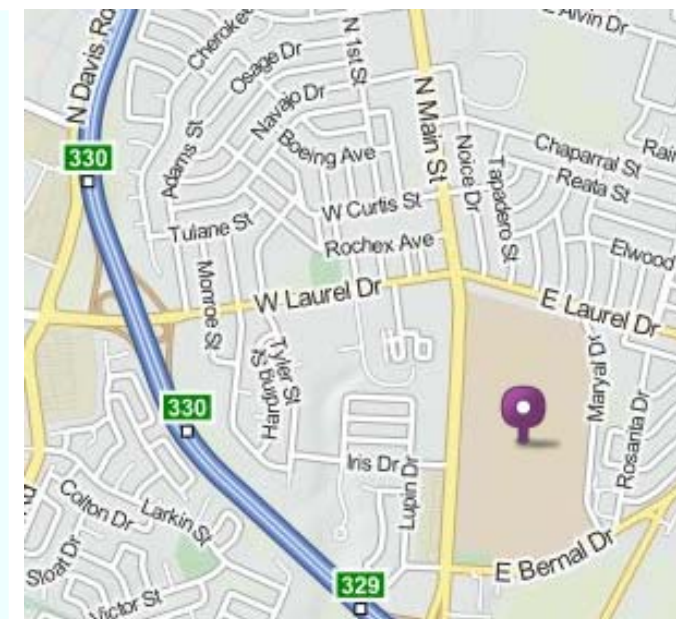
